**ORDINANCE NO. 20-2009(PSH), AS AMENDED, SECOND READING**, amending Chapter 751, *Commercial Snow Removal*, of Part Seven, *Business Regulations*, of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cleveland Heights to require the registration of persons providing commercial landscaping services within the City, to increase registration fees for persons subject to Chapter 751, to increase required property damage insurance limits for persons subject to Chapter 751, to prohibit the deposit of plant materials on the median strips, the paved portions of public rights-of-way and private property by persons subject to Chapter 751, to increase the penalty for second and subsequent offenses relating to the deposit of snow and plant material on the public rights-of-way and other unlawful locations by persons subject to Chapter 751 and to provide for revocation of permits for violations of the requirements of Chapter 751;
