Afterwards I moved to China and lived abroad for 4 years before returning to America to work in Cleveland at Jakprints. I have traveled all over the world and have lived in several US and international cities. As a Political Science major I focused heavily on comparative politics. Every city I have lived in has had a different set of policy initiatives, some successful others failures. I believe I would bring a positive progressive view to the city of Cleveland Heights and my ability to see other's points of view would allow me to work well with other council members who have a different perspective.

What educational training (formal or informal), employment and other life experiences have helped you develop the qualities, abilities, etc., described above?

Texas Tech University: Being a proud liberal in a proud conservative city was my first experience debating passionate conservatives, in our political science classes we frequently had these types of debates and more often than not I was able to reach across the aisle and get people from different poles to come together to support a decision. It was also at Texas Tech where I studied abroad in Seville, Spain where I took a comparative politics course called, Comparing Common Law & Civil Law, this was my first time living abroad and opened the door for me to move to China the very next year.

While living in China, I stayed for 4 years not once coming back to America. This 4 year leave allowed me to compare what was going on in America and in China. While both countries are not perfect, living abroad gave me the ability to see what China did great (infrastructure, high speedrailways) and what America did great (Freedom of Press, Media, ect). Living in China has made me envious of their infrastructure, and has made me passionate about bringing an effective Infrastructure policy plan to America.

When I came back from China I volunteered to go canvassing for the Bernie Sanders Campaign. I also started a non-profit organization called Amendable, with hopes of teaching younger kids, teens, and adults how policy is created with the goal of getting local communities more involved in the policy making process.

My biggest goal is infrastructure, from bike lanes, to bus routes I am determined to give our citizens a better way to get to work. I am deathly afraid of riding my bike to work, in China, I had metal fences blocking cars from the Bike Lane giving me an extra set of protection from the threat of cars. I would fight to give bikers a sense of peace and mind will commuting to work. I will also be fighting against bus fare raises, hoping to increase the time of waiting before buses and introducing new bus routes that can get people from point A to point B faster and more efficient.

I have a full time job at Jakprints, but as a developer I can make my hours fit around my schedule.
