Funder: The City of Cleveland Heights

Description: \$77,195 of 2019 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds are available to eligible entities to make strategic investments in the targeted areas specified in the attached map. Projects or programs must aid low-to-moderate income individuals, households, areas or job seekers or eliminate blighted conditions. Eligible projects or programs must also address one or more Master Plan Goal and/or Action identified in the City's Master Plan. A maximum of 15% or \$11,580 may be used for public service categories (activities that provide a service). Applicants with eligible projects will be asked to present their project or program at a Public Hearing in August, 2019. Applicants are strongly encouraged to discuss their application with the CDBG Administrator (contact info listed below) prior to submitting their application.

Funding Amount: \$77,195.00

Eligible Entities: Non-profits and units of local government.

Eligible Areas: Census Block Groups contiguous to and East of the Noble Road Corridor and Census Block Groups between Lee Road and South Taylor Road, South of Mayfield Road/Ivydale Road/Euclid Heights Boulevard and North of Cedar Road.

Application Period: June 5, 2019 through July 15, 2019

Award Date: Fall, 2018

Restrictions: All CDBG and other Federal Rules and Regulations apply.

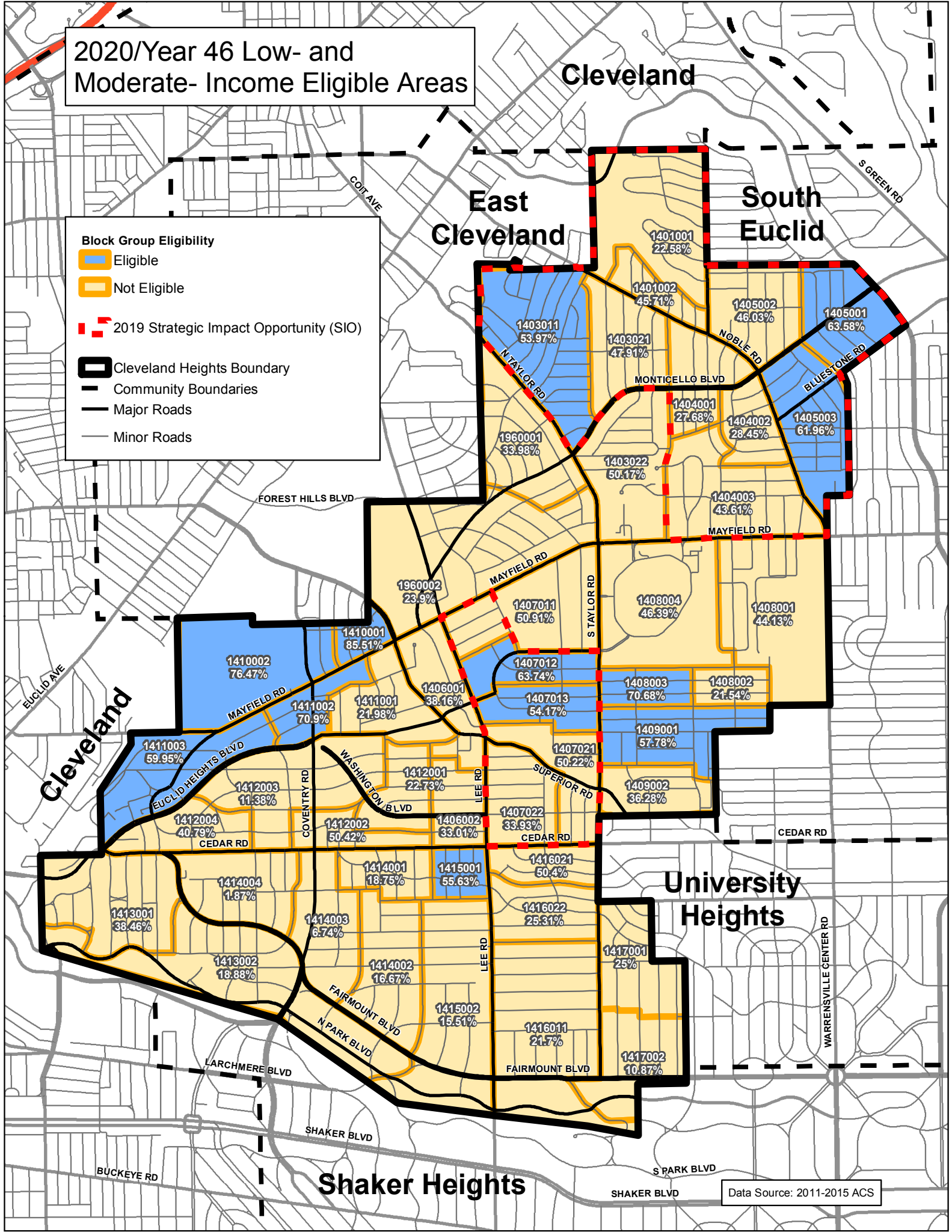
