RESOLUTION NO. 28-2015 (MS)

A Resolution authorizing the City Manager to enter into an agreement with GPD Group, for Construction Administration and resident inspection services for the Lee Road Streetscape Project; providing compensation therefor; and declaring an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City has entered to into an agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation ("ODOT") concerning the Lee Road Streetscape Project; and

WHEREAS, GPD Group has presented to the City an estimate of costs and a description of the Construction Administration and resident inspection services to be performed for this project, as required by ODOT regulations, and is well-qualified to perform all services contemplated; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended the employment of GPD Group for its professional services on this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cleveland Heights, Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City Manager be, and is hereby, authorized to enter into an agreement with GPD Group as a Construction Administrator for the construction administration services, and resident inspection services to be performed in connection with the Lee Road Streetscape Project. The particular services to be provided by GPD Group are as set forth in the proposal on file with the Clerk of Council.

SECTION 2. The fees to be paid to CT Consultants, Inc., for the aforesaid services shall be a sum not to exceed Two Hundred Eighty-Five Six Hundred One Dollars (\$285,601). All documents hereunder shall be in a form approved by the Director of Law.

SECTION 3. Notice of the passage of this Resolution shall be given by publishing the title and abstract of contents, prepared by the Director of Law, once in one newspaper of general circulation in the City of Cleveland Heights.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the inhabitants of the City of Cleveland Heights, such emergency being the need to commence the above-described improvements at the earliest possible time to protect the safety and welfare of those persons using the roads and streets of the City. Wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) or more of the members elected or appointed to this Council, this Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest time allowed by law.
