NEW BUSINESS and ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Pedestrian crossing enforcement issues:

Actions: Tell Joe Kickel about non-working Coventry crosswalk lights near Heights Hardware, request that City regularly evaluate pedestrian-actuated crosswalk lights, look into timing of Heights High school zone lights and study provision of a leading pedestrian interval for the traffic signals at Mayfield-Monticello and Mayfield-Superior.

- Noble Road "Street Furniture Bike Lane Pop Up"

Action: City staff to look into feasibility of temporary bike lanes. Laura to assess interest of Noble Neighbors at upcoming meeting.

- Bike Lane Ordinance (To clarify that presence of a bike lane does NOT require cyclist to use that lane; to make blocking a bike lane or encroachment beyond a solid lane line a ticketable offense: Pros & Cons): No action taken.
